

Mater DoLorosa Passionist Retreat



The Paschal Mystery – the life, passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ lies at the heart of Christian faith and life.

For one hundred years, the Paschal Mystery - with particular attention to the Passion of Jesus Christ - has been the focus of retreats at Mater Dolorosa. In the spirit of St. Paul of the Cross, Founder of the Passionists, his companions and followers have faithfully implemented his vision. The fruit of centuries of prayer and contemplation finds expression in the theme chosen for this retreat season.

All are encouraged to attend for spiritual invigoration. This year the retreat will be Fri. Sept. 20 to Sun. Sept. 22. The suggested donation for the weekend retreat is \$295 (which includes the \$50 deposit) for two nights' accommodations and five meals and conferences. For those with financial difficulty, the Council can provide scholarship assistance

Arrival and check is from 3:00-5:45 pm Friday. A supper in the dining hall opens the retreat on Friday at 5:45 pm followed by Orientation at 7:00 PM. The retreat closes Sunday about 12:30 PM.

North of I-210, Mater Dolorosa is located in the San Gabriel foothills. The center has air conditioned rooms (doubles and singles) with private baths, library, gift shop/bookstore, Chapel, outdoor Stations of the Cross, amphitheater, and special places of meditation—the Garden of the Seven Sorrows, the Blessed Sacrament Garden, and a meditation pergola overlooking the Los Angeles Basin.

Casual dress and comfortable shoes are recommended. Evenings tend to get cooler, please plan accordingly. Bedding, linens, and towels are provided. Please bring your own and hair dryer. The Retreat can accommodate special diet, wheelchair or require a room for physical disabilities, etc.

Driving Directions: From the WB 210 Freeway. Exit on Baldwin Ave and go straight up Baldwin to Sierra Madre Blvd., turn left and proceed to Sunnyside Ave. and turn right. Proceed to the end and through the gates of the Retreat Center.
