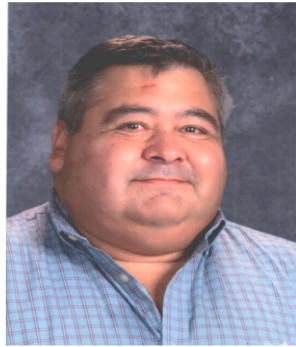

A MOMENT IN OUR HISTORY

.” . . .**ONE NATION UNDER GOD**” . . .In 1951, the KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS began including the phrase . . .”One Nation Under God” in the pledge of allegiance and adopted a resolution to include that phrase in all 4th Degree Assembly Meetings. Eventually the phrase became a part of the Knight’s of Columbus pledge. In 1953, at the suggestion of a correspondent, Rep. Louis C. Rabout (D-Mi) sponsored a resolution in the House of Representatives to include the phrase “in God We Trust” in the pledge. This effort to amend the Pledge of Allegiance languished in Congress until February 7, 1954. With President Eisenhower in attendance, the Church’s Pastor, George McPherson Docherty, delivered a sermon based on Lincoln’s Gettysburg Address stating that something was missing in our Pledge. Something that defined our American way of life. Our American heritage and character. He cited Lincoln’s words “Under God” as the defining words.

President Eisenhower, who had recently been baptized a Presbyterian just a year before, responded enthusiastically to Docherty’s suggestion and on February 8, 1954, Rep. Charles Oakman (R-Mi) introduced a bill to that effect. Congress passed the necessary legislation and Eisenhower signed the Bill into law on Flag Day, June 14, 1954.
