



Born at Milan, April 23, 1813; died at Marseilles, September 8, 1853. A brilliant apologist, impressed by the benefits of the

Christian religion, he desired that they should be made known to all who might read his works or hear his words." The Society of St. Vincent de Paul was established as "an international association of Catholic laymen engaging systematically in personal service of the poor; was founded in May, 1833, whose object should be to minister to the wants of the Parisian poor. The mastermind conceiving the project, which was destined to make an indelible impress upon the history of modern charity work, was Frederic Ozanam, a brilliant young Frenchman, lawyer, author and professor in Sorbonne" ("Society of Saint Vincent de Paul," Catholic Encyclopedia, vo.
